Consuelo González received her PhD in Economics and Business Administration from the University of Zaragoza. She is currently Associate professor of Management at the University of Zaragoza, where she teaches Strategic Management and Entrepreneurship. Her research primarily focuses on the analysis of institutions on level and type of entrepreneurship and the relationship between the creation and failure of companies and the institutional context. Its results have been published in some of the leading journals in the field, such as Small Business Economics and Business Strategy and the Environment, and have been presented at the main national and international conferences. She is a regular reviewer for several of the leading scientific journals in management and entrepreneurship. Since 2020, she has directed the GEM project in the Autonomous Community of Aragon and, since 2018 also, the GUESSS project. He has also participated as a researcher in several projects of the National Plan of R&D.
