Part B. CV SUMMARY (max. 3500 characters, including spaces)

Minerva González received his Ph.D. in Economics and Business Administration from the University of Zaragoza in 2019 where she had a pre-doctoral contract. Previously, she obtained her master's and bachelor's degrees at the University of Salamanca, where she was also a research fellow for 10 months between 2013 and 2014. She has been visiting scholar at Rotterdam School of Management for three months in 2019. She is currently an Assistant Professor of Management at the University of Zaragoza, where she teaches Strategic Management and Business Policy. Her research primarily focuses on the analysis of strategic decisions adopted by companies (mainly international decisions) and their performance. Also focuses on the institutional dynamism that impacts strategic decisions. Its results have been published in some of the leading journals of the IB field, such as *Global Strategy Journal* or *Journal of World Business* (indexed by AJG as 4 and Q1 in the JCR index). Her research has been awarded by the Spanish scientific business association, ACEDE, both for her role as a novel researcher and in the area of business strategy. In addition, she has participated in the organization and presentation in several conferences, as an evaluator for the main conferences in the area, as well as in research seminars.
